RECORD DESCRIPTIONS

PURPOSE

Overview

This documentation contains field locations and detailed descriptions of each data field for the different record segments on the National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) master file. In addition, an overview of how the file data are organized is provided. This should provide an understanding of the data so that it can be processed correctly. Both fixed-length and variable-length formatted field locations are enclosed and should be applied to whichever format is requested.

Standard Data Request Options

options are provided that can limit the amount of data received. For example, instead of receiving the entire NIBRS master file, perhaps all that is needed is the data from, say, a particular state. Various other data filters are available to further refine the data selection process on any subsequent data requests.

Custom Data Requests

Requests for master file records not falling within the available data filter options specified in this document will be assessed an additional processing fee to complete the request. An estimated completion date will also be provided based upon work priorities, availability of personnel, etc. The FBI UCR will provide total costs based upon the specific request before work is begun.

1. MAGNETIC MEDIA OPTIONS

The following tape and cartridge file attributes are available on data requests from the FBI. Default values (shown by underscore) are used when not specifically mentioned in the request. The default values are the most efficient way for the FBI to create the output tapes. When maximum block sizes are used, the number of output tapes/cartridges created will be the fewest, thereby reducing the overall cost of the request.

1) . UNIT=3480 : will write to cartridges.

UNIT=TAPE62 : will write to round reel tapes.

2) LABEL=SL : IBM Standard Labels are written.

Must be SL for UNIT=3480. If your
computer system cannot process SL
tapes, then use Bypass Label
Processing (BLP) on the Job Control

Language (JCL).

LABEL=NL : Non-Labeled. Only request NL if your computer system cannot read or

bypass Standard Labels (SL).

3) BLKSIZE=max : Maximum blocksizes are used to write as many records as possible on the tape. Reduced blocksizes will possibly increase the number of output tapes created.

Variable-Blocked (VB) = 32,760

Fixed-Block (FB) = 32,736

Note - must be a multiple of 132 for FB

2. DATA FILTER OPTIONS

Details of each option are provided that can limit the amount of data written to tape. Date Ranges of one day to a calendar year may be requested in combination with any of the following options: Number of months reported; "record set" limiter (e.g., restrict to Group "A" having multiple offenses); limit Group "A" offense code groups to 10 offense groups; limit Group "B" Arrest Report offenses to 3 offenses; limit states to 5 selections; and limit population groups to 5 selections.

As described above, the entire master file or a subset of the master can be requested based upon combinations of data filters set forth below. To be written to tape, each record set must satisfy all requested filter option(s).

A. DATE RANGE

The request can be for a single day, a range of days, or an entire calendar year.

Group "A" Incident Reports that have an incident date prior to the DATE RANGE requested (but not earlier than January 1 of the previous year) that has any "date" data element value in the DATE RANGE will be included depending on the FILTER OPTION requested. This will provide for tabulations such as how many arrests occurred in the DATE RANGE and what were the offenses associated with the incidents.

In all instances, any arrests, recovered property, or exceptional clearances occurring in the next year for incident dates retrieved by date range will be included.

Based on FILTER OPTIONS below, Group "A" Incident Reports will be selected by (1) incident date or (2) any "date" data element that has a date that falls within the date range.

B. NUMBER OF MONTHS

If not requested, all agency data are considered regardless of the number of months the agency reported data to the FBI. Should the request only want data from agencies that actually reported a certain number of months or greater (to include zero-reporting), then request that number of months.

C. RECORD SET LIMITERS

The following DATA FILTERS include only the specified "record set" and all other data are excluded:

MASTER FILE

A = INCLUDE all "record sets" in the master file whose "date" data element field shown below is within the date range.

For Group "A" Incident Reports, only those whose "incident date" is within the date range are included. Even though the incident might have "activity" in the date range, e.g., an arrest, if the incident occurred before the date range, it is excluded.

B = INCLUDE all "record sets" in the master file that have any "date" activity within the date range.

Group "A" Incident Reports whose incident date occurred on or after January 1 of the previous year and before the date range but having "activity" within the date range ARE also included.

GROUP "B" ARREST REPORTS

C = INCLUDE only Group "B" Arrest Reports whose arrest date is within the date range.

ARREST / EXCEPTIONAL CLEARANCES

D = INCLUDE only Group "A" Incident Reports having arrests whose "arrest date" is within the date range.

Group "A" Incident Reports whose incident date occurred on or after January 1 of the previous year and before the date range but having an "arrest" within the date range ARE included.

E = INCLUDE only "record sets" having arrests whose "arrest date" is within the date range. This covers Group "A" Incident Reports, Group "B" Arrest Reports, and Window arrests.

Group "A" Incident Reports whose incident date occurred on or after January 1 of the previous year and before the date range but having an "arrest" within the date range ARE included.

F = INCLUDE only "record sets" having any clearance whose clearance date is within the date range. This encompasses Group "A" Incident Reports that have arrests or are exceptionally cleared, Group "B" Arrest Reports, Window exceptional clearances, and Window arrests.

Group "A" Incident Reports whose incident date occurred on or after January 1 of the previous year and before the date range ARE included if they were cleared.

G = INCLUDE only Group "A" Incident Reports that do NOT have "arrest dates" within the date range but whose incident dates are within the date range. This in effect EXCLUDES all Group "A" Incident Reports having an "arrest date" within the date range.

RECOVERED PROPERTY

H = INCLUDE all "record sets" having recovered property whose "recovered property date" is within the date range. This covers Group "A" Incident Reports and Window recovered property.

Group "A" Incident Reports whose incident date occurred on or after January 1 of the previous year and before the date range but having "recovered property" within the date range <u>A R E</u> included.

MULTIPLE SEGMENTS

I = INCLUDE only "record sets" that have multiple offenses.

Group "A" Incident Reports whose incident date occurred on or after January 1 of the previous year and before the date range but having "activity" within the date range are NOT included.

Included are:

Record Set 1. Group "A" Incident Report 2. Window Exceptional Clearance 3. Window Recovered Property 4. Window Arrest Data Element Date Except. Clearance Recovered Property Arrest

- J = INCLUDE only Group "A" Incident Reports having multiple offenses where the "incident date" is within the date range.
- K = INCLUDE only Group "A" Incident Reports having multiple
 victims where the "incident date" is within the date
 range.
- L = INCLUDE only Group "A" Incident Reports having multiple offenders where the "incident date" is within the date range.

- M = INCLUDE only Group "A" Incident Reports having multiple arrestees where the "incident date" is within the date range.
- N = INCLUDE only Group "A" Incident Reports having multiple offenses, victims, offenders, or arrestees where the "incident date" is within the date range. Any incident containing a "multiple" will be included.

MISCELLANEOUS

P = INCLUDE only the "Batch Header" records. Information about each ORI is provided such as agency population, FIPS county code in which the agency resides, etc.

D. OFFENSE SELECTION

GROUP "A" INCIDENT REPORTS AND WINDOW RECORD SETS

The record selection can be limited to (1) up to 10 specific offense groups with all UCR offenses included within the group, (2) up to 5 specific UCR Offenses, (3) combinations of offense groups and specific offenses, or all groups if not requested. Each 1-character group code below will retrieve the applicable Group "A" Incident Report or Window Record Set when at least one of the offense segments for the Group "A" Incident Report or one of the window offenses contains the selected UCR offense code(s).

When requesting group codes containing multiple offenses or groups containing one offense, use the 1-character Group Code value in your request. Use the 3-character UCR offense code when requesting specific offenses within a group. In such cases, each specific UCR offense code reduces the 10 maximum offense group selections by 2. In other words, a maximum of five specific UCR offense codes are allowed if group codes are not used. Each 1-character group code reduces the maximum by 1, and each specific UCR offense code reduces it by 2.

F. STATE SELECTION

The record selection can be limited to select specific state(s). Up to 5 two-character state abbreviations can be specified. If no specific state is requested, all states will be included.

G. POPULATION GROUP SELECTION

The record selection can be limited to select specific population group(s). Up to 5 two-character groups can be specified. If no specific population group is requested, all groups will be included.

If groups 1A, 1B, and 1C are wanted, either request all three, or request 01. This will cause all three subgroups to be selected and reduces the maximum selections by one. The same applies to groups 01-07, 8A-8E and 9A-9E.

NOTICE

Requests for master file records not falling within the above options will be assessed an additional processing fee. The FBI UCR will provide total costs based upon the specific request prior to your receiving the data.

3. OVERVIEW OF RECORD SEGMENTS

A UCR originating agency identifier (ORI) Batch Header record, identified as Segment Level "Bx," is <u>always</u> the first record of all "record sets" for a particular UCR ORI. This record is significant in that it identifies the start of a new UCR ORI and also contains descriptive information about the ORI.

Each Batch Header is followed by available incident data after eliminating data falling outside any requested filter options. All data records following the Batch Header belong to the ORI of the Batch Header. The Batch Header record can be followed immediately by another Batch Header, which means there was no incident data for the UCR ORI or none was written based on any filter options selected.

Each incident "record set" has an ORI and Incident Number that together make an incident unique from all others. There may be incidents following the Batch Header that have a different ORI, but these should be considered part of the Batch Header in which they follow. Although positions 1-7 of the ORI will be identical in such instances, positions 8-9 can be different from the Batch Header's ORI in the same positions. Again, all data records following a Batch Header belong to the ORI of the Batch Header.

BATCH HEADER

This Segment Level provides descriptive information about the ORI such as population, judicial district, etc. All incident data that satisfies any requested filter options follow this record. The presence of this record indicates (1) the beginning of a different ORI and (2) that no more incident data exists for the previous Batch Header (assuming it's not the first record on the magnetic media).

LEVEL DESCRIPTION

BH BATCH HEADER

As stated above, this record identifies certain attributes about the UCR ORI. It will always be the first record and will be followed by any crime data for Segment Levels 01 through 07, W1, W3, and W6.

B1-B2-B3 Same data as BH, except the BH is broken up into three fixed-length records. If your request was for fixed-length records, instead of the BH there will be three "Bx" records.

GROUP "A" INCIDENT REPORT IS MADE UP OF MULTIPLE "SEGMENTS"

Each Group "A" Incident Report can contain up to six distinct records, each of which is referred to as a "Segment." An incident report may consist of many possible combinations of circumstances ranging from a simple one administrative, offense, victim, and offender situation, to a complex set of multiple offenses, property losses, victims, offenders, and arrestees. In addition, each of the victims may not be involved in each of the offenses. In other words, one, some, or all of the victims may be connected to each applicable offense.

The following sections will provide more detail as to what data are included within the various segments.

GROUP "A" INCIDENT REPORT SEGMENT LEVELS

There are six SEGMENT LEVELS within a Group "A" Incident Report. Position "5" of each record [Segment] will contain one of the following SEGMENT LEVEL codes (01-06) to indicate what kind of segment is being submitted. A brief description of each Segment Level follows:

LEVEL DESCRIPTION

01 ADMINISTRATIVE SEGMENT

Provides administrative information regarding the overall incident.

02 OFFENSE SEGMENT(S)

Provides information about the UCR Offense(s) involved in the incident.

LEVEL DESCRIPTION

03 PROPERTY SEGMENT(S)

Provides information about the various types of property losses, etc. involved in the incident.

04 VICTIM SEGMENT(S)

Provides information about the victim(s) involved in the incident.

05 OFFENDER SEGMENT(S)

Provides information about the offender(s) involved in the incident.

O6 ARRESTEE SEGMENT (8)

Provides information about the arrestee(s) involved in the incident.

GROUP "B" ARREST REPORT SEGMENT LEVEL

This Segment Level is for Group "B" offenses only. A Group "B" Arrest Report is present for each arrestee in a Group "B" offense.

LEVEL DESCRIPTION

GROUP "B" ARREST REPORT(S)

Provides data for arrests involving Group "B" offenses (e.g., Peeping Tom).

WINDOW SEGMENT LEVELS

These Segment Levels reflect data in which the complete Group "A" Incident Report was not submitted to the FBI; rather, only a portion of the incident was submitted. One reason that would generate a window submission to the FBI is if a summary-based agency converted over to incident-based reporting and, say, an arrest was subsequently made. Only the arrest would be submitted.

Instructions have been established that require submission to the FBI of window segments if the incident date occurred prior to the date the agency was officially submitting NIBRS data to the state. Rules have been established for submission of exceptional clearances, recovered property, and arrests for incidents no longer maintained by the local agency.

LEVEL DESCRIPTION

W1 EXCEPTIONAL CLEARANCE

Same data elements as Segment Level 01 plus up to 10 Group "A" offenses associated with the incident.

W3 RECOVERED PROPERTY(S)

Same data elements as Segment Level 03 plus up to 10 Group "A" property offenses associated with the incident.

W6 ARREST(S)

Same data elements as Segment Level 06 plus up to 10 Group "A" offenses associated with the incident.

4. SEQUENCE OF RECORD SEGMENTS

All records are in ascending order by numeric state code. All Batch Header records for a numeric state code are in ascending order by ORI. Incident "record sets" following a Batch Header record will have the same seven positions of the Batch Header's ORI, but may not be in ascending sequence by its 9-character ORI since the last two positions may be different.

Incident "record sets" within an ORI are not in order because the Incident Number is encrypted prior to writing it to tape. All record segments within an incident "record set" have the same incident number and are in ascending order by Segment Level (e.g., 01, 02, 03, 04, etc.). Segment Levels that can have multiple segments are further ordered in ascending sequence by their offense code, property loss code/property decription code, victim sequence number, offender sequence number, or arrest date.

Set forth below is an example to illustrate the order of records on the magnetic media:

5. SEGMENT LEVELS

INTRODUCTION

The displacements shown in "Record Position" are relative to 1; that is, the first character following any 4-byte record descriptor word (RDW) is shown in position one. If the data requested is in variable-length format and the RDW is presented to the application program as part of the record, add "4" to each displacement for the actual position on the physical data record.

Industry standards for some programming languages sometimes differ on whether or not to present the RDW to the application program reading the records. For example, in Assembler Language Coding (ALC), the RDW is always presented, in COBOL it is not. Displacements shown in this document do not reflect the RDW as part of the record.

There are 53 data elements associated with a NIBRS incident. When applicable, the data element number is shown to provide traceability back to any NIBRS document that references data by this number.

Data is written in EBCDIC.

Data fields not present will be set to blanks.

VARIABLE-LENGTH SEGMENTS

Each Segment Level has its own length and will be the length shown in the last "Record Position" displacement for that Segment Level. Add "4" bytes to account for the physical presence of the RDW.

FIXED-LENGTH SEGMENTS

Each Segment Level's length is 132 bytes and will be padded with trailing blanks as necessary. The longest variable-length Segment Level is the Property Segment which is 132 characters and the shortest is the Offender Segment which is 39 characters.
